SCHOLARSHIP FOR THE STUDENTS OF MINORITY COMMUNITIES

Ministry of Religious Affairs & Interfaith Harmony intends to award the subject scholarship to **poor, needy, orphan and handicapped students** of minority communities for the Academic Session 2025-26.

Eligibility Criteria:

1. Applicant must have scored at-least 50% marks and passed their paper in last year examination.
2. Candidate's parents income must not exceed Rs.80,000/= per month.
3. Orphans, handicapped, disabled, needy and poor students having good educational records.
4. The applicants must not getting Scholarship / Financial Assistance from any other source.
5. Use Blue ink for filling up and attesting the form.


Required Documents (Attested Copies):

1. University ID Card.
2. CNIC number of applicants or NADRA B-Form number for younger than 18 years must be mentioned on the forms.
3. Marks Certificate(s) of Last two Semesters (Spring & Fall) Examination.
4. Incase of First Year Engineering, the students required to submit their Intermediate and Matriculation Marksheets.
5. Current Gross Salary Certificate of father / guardian.

Incomplete applications forms will not be accepted.

Interested students may obtain the Prescribed Application Forms from the concerned Class Advisor / Portal www.pl The candidate needs to submit the application form along-with attested copies of required documents duly forwarded by concerned Class Advisor / Chairman of the respective department latest by **27-02-2026**. 

CRITERIA FOR
AWARDING SCHOLARSHIP TO MINORITY COMMUNITIES OF SINDH
(C.F.Y 2025-26)

- i. Regular Minority Students of Government Institutions (University Level only) who have passed their annual examination during the last one year and scored at least 50% marks, are eligible to apply. Students enrolled in BSC in Nursing course are also encouraged to apply only Government Medical Universities. In case of GPA System, evaluation sheet from the respective institution is must.
- ii. Candidate's Parent Income must not exceed Rs.80,000/- per month.
- iii. The application will be on New Prescribed Performa, duly supported with attested copy of marks sheet of last examination. In case of semester system attested copies of marks sheets for last semester and Father / Guardian's Parent Original Income Certificate.
- iv. Attested copy of University Identification Card.
- v. All particulars of the student concerned will be certified by the Head of Educational Institution, also verifying that attested copy of marks sheets of the last annual examination showing actual performance of the student are enclosed. **Marks sheet prepared** on printed form or plain paper afresh will not be accepted.
- vi. Head of Institution or employer should ensure correct financial position of student's parent / guardian before signing the Income Certificate.
- vii. Head of the Institution should check that forms are complete in all respect, required certificates / documents are attached and prepare a list of eligible students and send it to this Ministry along-with covering letter duly signed by him / her.
- viii. Students receiving financial assistance, stipend or scholarship etc from any other source will not be eligible.
- ix. CNIC/NADRA B-Form number (if under 18 years) attested copy must be attached.
- x. All columns of the New Application Form must be **filled in properly and carefully**, particularly the name of institution and class. Incomplete forms will not be accepted Students of private institutions are not eligible to submit applications otherwise their applications will be rejected at initial level.
- xi. No application will be entertain directly send by the candidates.
- xii. In case of application receipt in excess, will be short listed.
- xiii. The application Forms received after the closing date or on old Form may not be considered.
- xiv. Last date of submission of application(s) is **27.02.2026**.
