Undergraduate Scholarship Program . for Students of Gilgit-Baltistan

To Study in Top Pakistani Universities/Institutions.

Applications are invited from outstanding students of Gilgit-Baltistan who intend to pursue undergraduate studies (four/five years BS Programs) from HEC-recognized public sector Universities/Degree Awarding Institutions (DAIs). The Scholarships are being offered for the academic year 2023-24 in all areas of study/disciplines under the project titled, "Undergraduate Scholarship Program for the students of Gilgit-Baltistan in Top Pakistani Universities/Institutions (Batch-III)".

Eligibility Criteria

- Applicants must have domicile/local certificate of Gilgit-Baltistan.
- Applicants must have completed Higher Secondary School Certificate (HSSC)/Equivalent.
- Applicants who are already availing any other scholarship are NOT eligible to apply.
- Maximum age limit is 22 years as on closing date of application submission.
- The candidates will have to meet HEC and University criteria for admission in BS programs.

Scholarships Will Cover

- Tuition Fee, Hostel fee and other charges maximum Rs. 240,000 per year.
- Stipend of Rs. 15,000 per month.
- Books and traveling allowances of Rs. 30,000 per

Important Note

- Candidates will be shortlisted based on their scores in Aptitude Test (to be conducted by Education Testing Council, HEC) and academic credentials.
- Candidates must secure at least 50% marks in the
- Students already enrolled in any BS Program in public sector universities/institutions prior to the advertisement (maximum academic year/session) may also apply.
