1. **Academic Year:** any semester
2. **Capacity:** 10 Scholarship seats
3. **Gender Preference:** No gender preference

Eligibility Criteria:

- High potential candidates (Student must secure a minimum of 2.8 CGPA or 70% or above in inter for 1st semester students, to be eligible)
 - Must be enrolled in the following Undergraduate programs:
 - Mechanical Engineering
 - Electrical Engineering
 - Computer Science (CS)
 - Artificial Intelligence (AI)
 - Demonstrated financial need (**zakat 80% and saqda 20% seats**)
 - Strong and consistent academic performance
 - Students will be inducted under OTF's holistic program
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Nomination Instructions

1. NED will submit nominations for at least 18 students against a total of 10 available seats
 2. Nomination to be shared over email
 3. If in case selected students have paid their fee, OTF will disburse funds to the institute who may reimburse to the students
 4. Please ensure all nominations meet the year requirements.
 5. Nominations must be submitted to OTF no later than **19th August '26**
 6. Funds will be disbursed within 10 working days after OTF receives hard and softcopy invoices.
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Application Process

1. Students are required to complete and submit the Joint OTF x NED application form. Incomplete submissions will not be processed.
2. Associated forms and documents are to be submitted no **later than 19th August '26**.
3. Relevant academic and financial documents must be attached.
4. Ensure all nominated students have applied
